

FEDERAL FUNDING AND SAM.GOV

To receive federal funding after April 4, 2022, all libraries must have a new Unique Entity Identifier (UEI) through SAM.gov. This UEI is replacing DUNS Numbers.



WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR MY LIBRARY?

For a library to be eligible to apply for and receive federal funds after April 4, 2022, your library (including local government units acting as a fiscal agent) will need to obtain a UEI. If your library's county/municipality or institution holds the DUNS number for your library, please contact your county/municipality to ensure they've completed the DUNS to UEI transition

HOW TO CHECK IF REGISTERED AND TO REGISTER

First you need to check with your county/municipality government to find out if they are registered. If they are your fiscal agent you will use their UEI. If not, you will need to register at SAM.gov. After you are registered, you will need to update the information annually to maintain your registered status. This is a free service and you should never pay to register or update your registration
